

Higher Level Skills Fee Information Form

This qualification, CPC40110 Certificate IV in Building and Construction (Building) is funded by the Queensland Government under its Higher Level Skills Program.

While the Queensland Government funds some of the qualification, it does not fund all of the cost, and each participant is expected to contribute toward the overall cost of the unit and/or course. This is called a 'co-contribution' fee.

Non-concessional co-contribution fee

The non-concessional co-contribution fee for EACH unit is \$55.00 (\$880 total course cost). You will have to pay this fee if you **DO NOT** fall into one of the following categories:

- Hold an Australian Government low income health care card.
- Hold an Australian Government pensioner concession card.
- Are an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander.
- Have a disability and receive a disability pension.

Concessional co-contribution fee

The concessional co-contribution fee for EACH unit is \$40.00 (\$640 total course cost). You will have to pay this fee if you fall into one of the following categories:

- Hold an Australian Government low income health care card.
- Hold an Australian Government pensioner concession card.
- Are an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander.
- Have a disability and receive a disability pension.

You will be required to upload evidence of one of the above in our system.
